While I was researching material for this article, I came across a small reference about Native American Clowns. I began to explore a little more and found a plethora of material on the subject and will share some of that information with you.

Nearly all Native American tribes have a jester or trickster character that we would call a clown. There are many names given to these clowns by the various tribes that I will not go into at this time, because it would take the entire article just to print the different names. Nearly all of these clown wore makeup, often with stripes or black circles around their mouth and eyes. If they did not wear makeup, they would wear a mask or head dress. These clowns would diffuse tribal tension through their humorous interpretation of the tribes popular culture, reinforcing taboos and communicating traditions.

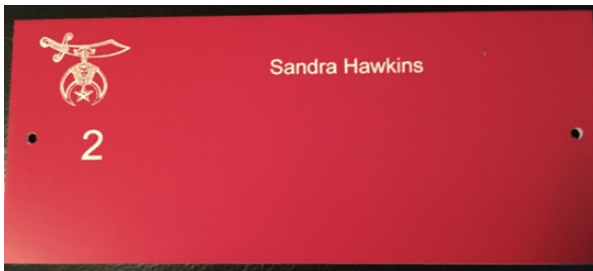
FLIVVERS**Dave Harvey**
