Thoughts from the Chief Rabban

Nobles of Zelzah Shrine:

It seems that many of you believe that all there is to being a Shriner is paying your dues and coming to meetings or Shrine functions. This month, I want to address: Pitching in to accomplish a task and cleaning up after yourself. When I joined the Shrine back in 2013 and we moved to this location, it was not unusual to see the Potentate, Past Potentates and other nobles pitching in to get the meeting room and kitchen cleaned up after a meeting or Shrine function so everyone could go home at a reasonable hour. Many of you now seem to think that there is a cleaning crew that comes behind you to clean up the meeting room, bathrooms, kitchen, and wash the dishes, glasses, and cups. Although there is a contracted cleaner, that individual only cleans the meeting room and bathrooms once a month (the weekend before the stated meeting). Other than that one time a month, it falls upon the nobles of this fraternity to clean up and keep our meeting room, kitchen, and bathrooms cleaned the rest of the time. I have happily come in the next day to clean up after our meeting and functions because I know many of you are still working full time, but I should not have to come in and clean urine off toilet seats and the floors around the toilets and urinals and pick up paper towels off the floors because a noble did not take the time to clean up after himself. In the meeting room, I should not be finding toothpicks, napkins, plastic glasses, and other trash thrown on the floors instead of being put in one of the several trash cans available for this type of trash. Additionally, our Purveyor and his Lady should not have to clean up the kitchen and wash all the dishes after meetings or Shrine functions by themselves. He does not charge the Shrine for his time, labor, or culinary skills, so it is not right to expect him and his Lady, to do all the cleaning by themselves. He also should not have to ask for assistance, nobles should just go in and start helping with the cleanup of the kitchen after the meeting or Shrine function. If Nobles would get up and help clean the meeting room, bathrooms, and kitchen after a meeting or Shrine function, then everyone could go home at a decent time instead of the one Noble tasked with closing the meeting room and the Purveyor and his Lady being here for up to two hours after everyone has left cleaning before they can go home. Our Purveyor lives in Pahrump, so on those nights that he does not stay in town because he has children and a business in Pahrump to get back to, he has an additional two-hour drive home. In most instances, I have advised the Noble tasked with closing the meeting room and the Purveyor not to worry about the floors or bathrooms, as I will come in the next day and clean, but if a few Nobles would stay and help I would not need to come in and spend an entire afternoon cleaning after a meeting or Shrine function. So, I am asking my Brother Nobles to clean up after themselves and get back to working together to accomplish the task of cleaning and keeping our Shrine Meeting Room and Kitchen clean.
