

Those who attended were thanked by the councilman for all the hard work you do for the community. This was an incredible honor to receive this proclamation from the City of Las Vegas.

Our Legion of Honor performed the presentation of the colors at the Pasadena Board of Governors meeting on Wednesday, October 6, 2021. They did an excellent presentation. We all should be so proud of their performance.

The fencing project is being diligently worked on to fence the back and side area of the building. We are getting estimates now for the project.

This meeting was very productive, and each group came away feeling that the way forward will lead to a positive outcome for our clinic and the children of Southern Nevada. We will continue to pursue the establishment of this clinic until we successfully complete this task. On October 13, Zelzah Shriners welcomed eight visiting Nobles from Mabuhay Shriners. It is my opinion these visiting Nobles went away with an incredibly positive view of Zelzah Shriners. There was even discussion about our Nobles visiting their Shrine Center in the Republic of the Philippines.





This proclamation is part of the work that the Divan is doing to further relations between the Temple and local, state, and federal government to help boost our projects like the planned Shriners Children's Clinic for Las Vegas. Having these relationships and getting the Shrine in the public eye only helps to further our work in Southern Nevada.

We are also looking to build our relationship with the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department as they can play a big part in helping improve the security on our property. Overall the PR Goal of enhancing Zelzah's visibility is paying off with more events and meetings to come during the rest of the year and into 2022.





High Priest & Prophet

A continuation of the Ancient Order Nobles of the Mystic Shrine short history.

In the early 1900's, membership grew rapidly and as well the range of Temples widened. In 18 years there were Temples in Canada, Hawaii, Mexico, and Panama, Canal Zone. The organization became the Ancient Order of Nobles of the Mystic Shrine for North America. The first Shrine Circus is believed to have opened in 1906 in Detroit.

The Shrine gave aid to the 1906 San Francisco earthquake and in 1915, the Shrine contributed to relief of European war victims.

In 1921 at the Imperial Session in Des Moines, Iowa, the proposal to create a charity for crippled children was passed and before the 1922 session the cornerstone for the first hospitals for Crippled Children in Shreveport, La. The rules were no one would be charged for the orthopedic care if they could not afford it for children of 14 years of age and it was thought they could be helped. This later changed to 18 years of age. This work is supervised by the Board of Trustees, who are elected annually and serve without pay. Each Hospital was governed by a local Board of Trustees, all members are Shriners.

The Hospitals are funded by a percentage of Shrine dues and endowment fund as well as fund-raising temple activities.


They also do research activities and now spend more than 14 million dollars, a year on several children's diseases.



Oriental Guide Must Be Selected Wisely Election of Zelzah Officers December 21, 2021

When the members of Zelzah Shriners elect a Noble to the Office of Oriental Guide, they are virtually starting that Noble through the Divan Line on the assumption that he will prove qualified for and worthy of advancement to the high office of illustrious Potentate.

Hence it is quite evident that nomination for Oriental Guide should be based upon thorough and accurate evaluation of character, ability, motivation, interest and experience. A Noble can be a great fellow, hard worker; and loyal Shriner and yet lack the basic qualification which make for a good Potentate. Unless a Noble is fully qualified for the job, he is unfair both to himself and to Zelzah Shriners in seeking the Office or I permitting his fellow Nobles to support and promote his candidacy.

Each Shrine Temple needs and requires capable, high type leadership. The normal starting point of that leadership is the office of Oriental Guide. The following checklist may prove helpful in evaluating potential candidates for the Office of Oriental Guide. However, no thinking man would be so naïve or presumptuous as to believe that any one Noble could possibly embody all of the virtues, talents and qualifications which are set forth in this check list. Nevertheless the list has practical value for self-evaluation by the Noble whose ultimate aspiration is the Office of Illustrious Potentate and for evaluation of potential candidates by the voting members.


