The First Meeting

On September 26, 1872, in the New York City Masonic Hall, the first Shrine Temple in the United States was organized. Brother McClenachan and Dr. Fleming had completed the ritual and proposed that the first Temple be named Mecca. The original 13 Masons of the Knickerbocker Cottage lunch group were named Charter Members of Mecca Temple. Noble Florence read a letter outlining the "history" of the Order and giving advice on conduct of meetings. The first officers were then elected.

The organization was not an instant success, even though a second Temple was chartered in Rochester in 1875. Four years after the Shrine's beginnings, there were only 43 Shriners and all but six of whom were from New York.

At a meeting of Mecca Shriners on June 6, 1876, a new governing body was created called "The Imperial Grand Council of the Ancient Arabic Order of the Nobles of the Mystic Shrine for the United States of America". The initiation ritual was embellished and as was the mythology about the fraternity. A publicity and recruiting campaign was initiated. In two years there were 425 Shriners in 13 Temples in 8 states.

Thoughts from the Chief Rabban Alan Wise

As we begin the final quarter of 2021, we can be justly proud of the year we have had so far. Our Potentate set his sights on making this year better as we came out of the COVID year of 2020. He established an entertainment committee to ensure our Nobles, their families and Masons and non-Masons could come together for fun and entertainment. His entertainment committee has met that challenge and we have developed new Nobles because of those entertainment events. He sought to reduce costs involved in running our Shrine and improve fundraising to cover the costs associated with the operation of the Shrine by appointing a budget committee and having regular meetings and reviews of the budget when needed to ensure his goal of reducing costs and improving fundraising was met. While doing this he has sought to improve the Shrine facility and our business infrastructure. Along with his team, he fought hard for a positive outcome in the Shrine's deal with the city for the purchase of Shrine property for the new bus stop. As a result of his team's work the Shrine received \$190K+ for the land sold to the city for the bus stop. He has overseen the improvement of lighting in the parking lot and around our business building; new sidewalk for the business area; a new security system for the office, meeting room and the business area; improvements in the audio/visual equipment and meeting room infrastructure; and plans to fence in the back area behind the business area and make repairs and improvements to the parking lot.

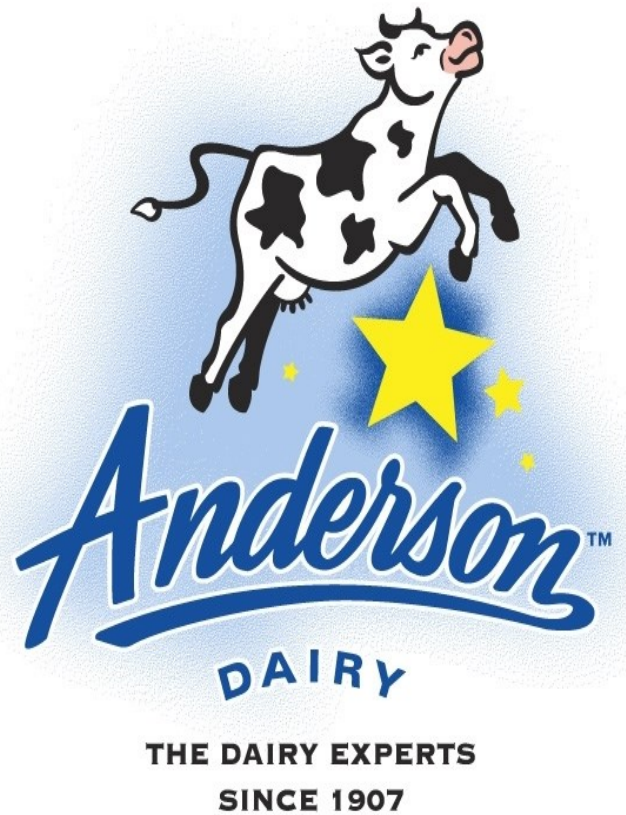
Although this year has seen the loss of some fine Nobles to the Black Camel, the Shrine has made strides in bringing in new Nobles with a record year for new members. The Potentate challenged the membership committee and the nobility to reverse the past few years decline in membership. Robert Adams and now Chuck Barone have taken up that challenge as the committee chair for the membership committee and with the help of the nobility have made positive strides in raising our numbers.

As we move into this final quarter, let's continue the positive progress we have made this year. Let us continue to show the Zelzah pride we have in our fraternity by supporting upcoming events and functions to the best of our ability. In October, we will be supporting the Shriners Children's Open, the Shriners Children's Southern California Board of Governors meeting here in Las Vegas the week of the open. The propose changes below will be voted on in October 26, 2021 Stated Meeting

Resolution 1: Proposed amendment of Article IX, Temple Units and Shrine Clubs, paragraph 9.3 Membership (a) Units:

The Motor Patrol Unit hereby proposes the Zelzah Shriners Bylaws 2017 be amended:

Currently paragraph 9.3 (a) reads: Temple units must be composed solely of members of this temple. The fez of the temple must be worn at all appropriate times except for such units which do not normally wear fezzes.

Proposed amendment: Temple units **may include Nobles of other temples with the approval of the Potentate of the other temple.** The fez of the temple must be worn at all appropriate times except for such units which do not normally wear fezzes, **unless an alternative headgear is approved by the Potentate.**

Review of the Shrine International Bylaws shows no conflict with the proposed amendment.

Resolution 2: Proposed amendment of Article III, Temple Meetings & Ceremonials, paragraph 3.1 Stated Meetings.

The Temple Recorder hereby proposes the Zelzah Shriners Bylaws 2017 be amended:

Currently paragraph 3.1 reads: A stated meeting shall be held on the fourth Tuesday of each month (except July), at 7:00 P.M.

Proposed amendment: A stated meeting shall be held on the fourth Tuesday of each month (except July **and August**), at 7:00 P.M.

Review of the Shrine International Bylaws shows no conflict with the proposed amendment.

All Unit and Clubs must hold Elections and submit results to the office no later then October 30th, per Imperial bylaws.
