# **Non-Destructive Testing Consulting**

The Imperial Session was enjoyable this year. Our representatives were kept busy during the business meetings. They did have some time to meet and make new friendships as well as renewing old friendships during the session. Evenings were spent with other Nobles and Ladies from around the world. We attended the Imperial parade and saw many units and clubs involved. This parade route was over three miles long, and our very own, Noble Mike Kearns, was a member of the ILOH's color guard which led the parade from beginning to end. One of the highlights of the session was the fez exchange between the Potentates of Agila Shriners and Zelzah Shriners during the temple's imperial session dinner. We were joined this year by Nobles from Agila Shriners and a Noble and Lady from Kerak Shriners.

The parking lot and fencing projects have been completed and I have received positive comments from both tenants and others who have come to the Eastern Village Business Center. If you haven't had the opportunity to come by and see the completed work I encourage you to come by. These projects will only increase the value of the business center in addition to giving us additional parking spaces.

In addition to the projects being completed we have gained two additional handicap parking spaces in front of the bar and now there are three spaces in front of the current Zelzah Shrine meeting room. As soon as all hardware is received, I will be putting up additional signs around the center as well as marking the new handicap parking spaces with signage in addition to the painted signage on the asphalt. All spaces are now clearly marked and all are proportional. Additionally, we have two marked motorcycle parking spaces out front. There is only loading and unloading spaces near our trailer storage area now which will make it easier to pull the trailers out and return them to the storage area. Finally, as part of the clean up after the asphalt was laid in the front, Las Vegas Paving repaired some spots in the business center sidewalk.

The Board of Directors will be working on a schedule to remove everything from the current meeting room. Some items will go to our storage room at Vegas 32, while other items will be stored in the storage buildings and some items will move to the office for display there. Once the BOD gets a schedule completed I will be asking for volunteers to assist with moving items to where they need to be.

Enjoy the rest of your summer and remember the business office is open during its summer hours: Monday – Thursday, 9 am – 4 pm, to provide you with your Shrine needs. The business office will return to business hours on September 2<sup>nd</sup> when hours will be: Monday – Thursday, 9 am – 4 pm and Friday, 9 am – 3 pm and closed on holidays.
