



Legion of Honor (LOH) Reggie

FLAG ETIQUETTE: The proper display of the US Flags during events: "Stated Meetings, other functions and parades" is vital to who we are as a Nation, Country, and Shriners. The Fez is considered a part of the uniform of a Shriner. There are some things that we can probably get away with, but misrepresenting the US Flag is not one of them. When at a stated meeting or other indoor function, a Noble who is wearing his Fez will execute a right-hand salute when the Flag Bearing begins to move and hold the salute until the colors are posted and after the Shriners Pledge of Allegiance or the Pledge of Allegiance to the US Flag and during the playing of the National Anthem of any "state" represented by Shriners International. At a parade if not participating and wearing a fez a noble will only execute a right-hand salute when the Colors of a temple are within six paces of him (he will not remove his fez) and will drop his salute after the Temple's Colors pass for all other Color Guards he will remove his fez and place it over his heart until the colors have passed. If not wearing the fez a noble will place his right hand over his heart when the Colors are within six paces and will drop his arm after the Colors pass.

PROTOCOL FOR POSTING OF THE US FLAG DURING STATED MEETINGS AND OTHER FUNCTIONS WHEN WEARING THE FEZ: In accordance with Shriners International Protocol: The military salute is used when reciting the Shrine Pledge of Allegiance or the Pledge of Allegiance to the US Flag and during the playing of the National Anthem of any "state" represented by Shriners International. During the posting of colors at a stated meeting or other function the manner of delivery The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag should be: If wearing the fez, a noble will face the flag, come to attention, and execute a right-hand salute and hold the salute until the Colors are posted and after the Pledge of Allegiance and/or playing of the national anthem. When not in a uniform of a Shriner, men if wearing a headdress should remove their headdress with their right hand and hold it at the left shoulder, the hand being over the heart.

The following is the protocol for the Presentation of Colors at our Stated Meetings.

After the prayer is given, the Potentate will state "Legion of Honor, Post the Colors or US Flag".

The Flag Carrier or Bearer will grab the Colors from the staff (if he does not already have it in his possession).

The LOH Captain of the Guard (COG) will state: "**DETAIL ATTENTION**". The flag bearer will come to attention, and place the flag to his right, with the staff pointed in a vertical position with the US Colors pointed up.

The COG will command the Detail "FORWARD MARCH", the flag bear and those in the detail will step off with their left foot moving forward towards the location of where the flag will be posted. Nobles will automatically come to attention and render a RIGHT HAND SALUTE and hold the salute until after the colors are posted and the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag recited and the COG commands "Order Arms".

The COG will command the "DETAIL HALT", stopping within 3-5 feet of the flag base.

The COG will command the Flag Bearer to Post the Colors. The Flag Bearer will approach the base of the flag stand and place the US Flag in its appropriate position. The Flag Bearer will step back about 1-2 feet. The COG will then issue the command "PRESENT ARMS", and the detail will present arms, and everyone will recite the Pledge of Allegiance in unison with the COG.

Upon completion of reciting the Pledge of Allegiance, the COG will command "ORDER ARMS" to everyone. Everyone will drop their salute and remain at attention.

The COG will then command the detail to "ABOUT FACE", then issue the command "FORWARD MARCH". The detail will step off on the left foot to their area of dismissal. The COG will command the Detail to Halt and then issue a Command to dismiss. The detail will stop, then dismiss, quietly so as not to cause any disruption to the meeting taking place.

The Potentate will then seat everyone, and the meeting will proceed.


