
Zelzah Shriners will be doing some projects this year to improve the facilities and parking space here at our Eastern Village business center. I ask you to work with the Potentate, Board of Directors, and myself as we are moving forward with these improvements to our business center. Please when the Potentate, the Board of Directors, or I come to you with a request for assistance with a project or need around our business center help us if you can as we really need assistance and in most cases this request will require less than a day to accomplish and in most cases just a couple of hours if there are several Nobles assisting with the tasking. Remember, this business center provides the bulk of monies used to keep our doors open so we may enjoy our events and support the philanthropy that helps the children that come to us for medical care through the Shriners Children's medical system.

There is still a need for van drivers to transport our Shrine patients to their medical appointments and surgeries in Pasadena. Our normal days for transportation are Monday through Thursday. Occasionally, there is a need for transportation on Friday, but these are the exception rather than the rule. We must have two drivers for each trip and one of the drivers must be a Zelzah Shriner. We currently have seven Zelzah Shriners who are active drivers, but several of those Nobles can only go on specific days throughout the month. If you can give us a day or more during the month that you can drive please contact Mrs. Wise at the office during normal business hours and she will get you set up. We will make sure that you are given at least one orientation run and will endeavor to ensure that you are paired with a driver who has experience in making these runs.

Finally, I want to thank you for the confidence you continue to place in me by electing me to serve as your Recorder and further to serve as a member of the Shriners Children's Southern California Board of Governors for the Medical Center located in Pasadena, California. I will continue to perform my duties to the best of my ability and serve Zelzah Shriners with honor and dignity.





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
