





At the called meeting of April 21, 2025, a motion was made and seconded to change the location of the Zelzah Shrine meetings and events room from its current location, 2327 S. Eastern Avenue to 632 E. Charleston Boulevard (Vegas Lodge 32 Facility). After a discussion by both those in favor of the move and those opposed to the move a vote was taken. Of the 64 Nobles signed in for the meeting, fifty-five members voted in favor of the move. As this exceeded the two-thirds required for passage the motion was approved.

So, what does this mean now? We have been working with the Vegas Lodge 32 Secretary to get our stated meetings, known events, and unit and club meeting put onto their calendar starting in September 2025. As this facility is gated we will be given a gate code to use when we are utilizing the building. This code will need to be safeguarded as this is how they track who is in the building and parking lot. Units and clubs will need to coordinate their meetings with the office so that they will have access to the building as only two keys will be issued. As we will now be tenants of this building we will need to be good tenants who clean up after themselves, which will mean that we will have to work as a team to ensure the building is in as clean or better condition than we found it. It also means that we cannot walk out and leave the purveyor to clean up the kitchen by himself even if he says he is fine, please pitch in and help with the dishes, trash, etc. This will be especially important if we start inviting our ladies to join us on meeting nights or when they are there for our events.

Our Membership Chair, Noble Raymond Roberts, is working hard to get those Brothers or others interested in becoming a Shriner helped so they can either become a Shriner if they are a Master Mason or help an interested man to begin his Masonic journey. Thanks to him and your assistance the "Unpaid Members of Zelzah Shriners" or non-payment of dues list is down to thirty-two (32) Nobles who have not yet paid their 2025 dues, per capita and hospital fee. I encourage you to take a look at the list and contact those Nobles you know to find out if there is some sort of problem concerning their paying their dues. If there is please refer them to me so that I can try to assist them.

Our paving project is scheduled to begin on June 9, 2025, with paving of the backlot and a portion of the front lot behind and in front of Jake's Bar. Phase one of this project is expected to be completed by June 15, 2025, so we should be able to park in the backlot for our June Stated Meeting scheduled for June 17, 2025. Phase two of the paving project will begin on June 16, 2025, and be completed by June 20, 2025. This will close down the entrance in front of our meeting room and the parking area for a portion of the front parking lot. (See the photo of the paving project in this issue of Zelzah Newsletter.)

On a final note, this month, I would like to thank Noble Todd Brown for his assistance with the cleaning up of the backlot area along the fence our property share with the city park. His hard work ensured the area was completely cleaned and picked up improving the appearance of the lot and getting it ready for the paving project.

Nobles:






