I would like to talk about two ways Zelzah Shrine Temple supports our philanthropy and child patients and the assistance needed to keep our meeting room pest free.

First, I would like to talk about our van drivers. Each trip we make requires two drivers, one of whom must be a Shriner. Currently, we have 17 van drivers; however, one driver recently took himself off the active list due to medical reasons leaving us with 16 drivers. Of those 16 drivers (11 Shriners and 5 Shrine Ladies) only six of these drivers (4 Nobles and 2 Ladies) are under the age of 60. Is this a problem, in simple language, YES. Our senior drivers can and are facing medical issues of their own, but their passion and allegiance to this fraternity and its philanthropy drive them to continue doing the work needed to support both. Of the 6 drivers under the age of 60 since they have signed up to drive only 2 have actually transported a child to the medical center. One of those drivers has made 20 trips since she signed up in 2020, while the other who signed up in 2022 has made 1 trip. The other 4 drivers were not available to drive on the days we asked them to drive. During 2022 there were 29 trips to the medical center transporting 19 different children. Nobles Cliff Reay and Tim Smith made 9 trips each. Making 7 runs each were Shrine Ladies Maureen Cronan and Inge Lindsey, Noble Kenny Keil, and myself. First Lady Bette Holmstrom made 6 trips, while First Lady Tammy Wise made five 5 trips, and Noble Raymond Roberts made 1 trip. This year through March, we have made a total of 7 trips transporting 5 different children. Only 1 of the drivers on these trips was under the age of 60. We would like to have some more younger drivers who are available to drive so our older drivers can pass the torch on this important function, but until these younger drivers sep forward and take on this responsibility in more numbers, our more senior volunteer drivers have to carry the load as many of the families we support aren't able to make that drive themselves due to financial or other reasons.

Second, I would like to speak about our efforts to raise funds for our philanthropy. This Shrine does not raise funds for the Shriners Hospitals for Children or the Shriners Children Southern California medical center on a regular or annual basis beyond what our individual Nobles do on their own that I can find. However, there is one fundraiser that supports our Shriners Childrens Southern California medical center on a regular basis involving Zelzah Shriners. It is the concert series CD and guitar sales headed by Ill Sir Dan Kelly. During the most recent concert run (8 nights) Zelzah Shriners, their ladies, and friends raised approximately \$40K for the medical center. To do this 12 Shriners, 6 Shrine Ladies, 1 Shrine family member, 1 El Giza Temple No. 139, DON Lady, 1

ZelNeva Court No. 96, LOSNA Lady, and 4 friends worked one or more nights supporting this effort. On the night of the Potentate's Ball, March 25th, Noble Chuck Cortez worked by himself to support this fundraising effort. These individuals are to be commended for their efforts to support our philanthropy. Additionally, Ill Sir Kelly received a Foreign Autographed guitar for presentation to the Shriners Children Southern California medical center on behalf of Zelzah Shriners and Friends because of the outstanding support provided during the concert series. This is an easy way to help support our philanthropy; it costs only some time. So, the next time Ill Sir Dan Kelly is looking for help to support one of these concerts, please volunteer to help raise funds for our philanthropy because you are helping our children.



We have arrested the pest problem we were having down in the meeting room. The pest control folks have indicated that they have found no additional pest problems. I would ask all who use the meeting room to be conscious of making sure that the meeting room is left in a clean condition and that all trash is removed from everywhere including the kitchen. Please do not leave open containers or food out when you depart after your meeting, event, or function, because doing so could result in a reinfestation and would lead to additional costs that are not budgeted for by the Potentate in his annual budget.

Finally, your office staff is here to provide support and assistance to you and your families as they participate in our Shrine functions throughout the year. Our office hours are Monday – Thursday, 9:00 am – 4:00 pm, and Friday, 9:00 am – 3:00 pm except for holidays and other announced closures. We invite you to visit us during business hours so we may assist you with your Shrine needs.

TOTAL PER PERSON: \$77.00


You can have a separate bar tab with the server that you can cover on your own.







