



From The Desk of The Recorder

April was a very full month and included the following highlights.

On April 2, 2025, the Potentate, Ill Sir Eric Halberg, the Patient Coordinator, Lady Tammy Wise, Noble William "Buck" and Lady Chris Hogan, and I went to visit with Noble Marion "Butch" and Lady Susan Madden at the care facility where Noble Butch and Lady Susan are living. We had an enjoyable visit with Noble Butch and Lady Susan. There was an ulterior motive for our visit with Noble Butch. Through Noble Buck I learned that Noble Butch was just three (3) hospital van trips short of five hundred (500) trips. After discussion with other hospital van drivers, three of our drivers decided to dedicate their next trip to Pasadena to Noble Butch Madden so that we could get him to 500 trips. After this was accomplished, we had a plaque made for a small Walking Tall Statue. 
