

Until such time as we are notified, we are required to purchase the tickets for our children and their guardian/parent.











Oriental Guide Must Be Selected Wisely Election of Zelzah Officers December 16, 2025

When the members of Zelzah Shriners elect a Noble to the Office of Oriental Guide, they are virtually starting that Noble through the Divan Line on the assumption that he will prove qualified for and worthy of advancement to the high office of Illustrious Potentate.

Hence it is quite evident that nomination for Oriental Guide should be based upon a thorough and accurate evaluation of character, ability, motivation, interest, and experience. A Noble can be a great fellow, hard worker; and loyal Shriner and yet lack the basic qualifications which make for a good Potentate. Unless a Noble is fully qualified for the job, he is unfair both to himself and to Zelzah Shriners in seeking the Office or permitting his fellow Nobles to support and promote his candidacy.

Each Shrine Temple needs and requires capable, high-type leadership. The normal starting point of that leadership is the office of Oriental Guide. The following checklist may prove helpful in evaluating potential candidates for the Office of Oriental Guide. However, no thinking man would be so naïve or presumptuous as to believe that any one Noble could possibly embody all of the virtues, talents, and qualifications that are set forth in this checklist. Nevertheless, the list has practical value for self-evaluation by the Noble whose ultimate aspiration is the Office of Illustrious Potentate, and for evaluation of potential candidates by the voting members.

Executive ability
Community standing and influence
Financial security
Business Sense
Energy and Vitality
Capable of building good public relations
Good habits and moral character
Well-Poised

Many temples have placed a definite limitation upon their progress as a result of hasty judgment in connection with nominations for the office of Oriental Guide. Every Noble is not fit to meet the rigorous demands placed upon Potentates. So let's be fair, honest, and wise in the all-important matter of electing to office only men who are eminently qualified for the job. We all know that with honor comes responsibility. While there is high honor associated with being a Divan Officer, the ensuing responsibilities entail a lot of time and energy-consuming work. Eternal vigilance must be wisely and thoughtfully exercised by the voting membership to perpetuate a high caliber of leadership.

ATTENTION ALL NOBLES

Stated Meeting & Elections of 2026 Officers Tuesday, December 16, 2025

§ 325.5 Ballot.

(a) Separate Ballot. Election of officers shall be by a majority vote of those present and voting. When there is more than one candidate for election to a particular office, a separate written ballot is required. A blanket ballot is prohibited.

Amend. 2012

§ 325.11 Election Regulations.

- (a) Electioneering. A candidate for an elected office in a Shrine temple may print, publish, and circulate during the year he is seeking the elected office, a resume consisting of his educational background, his vocational history, and his Masonic and Shrine record. Except as provided in the prior sentence, the printing, publication, circulating or distribution of resolutions, letters, telegrams, tickets, emails or other devices, by a unit, club, Nobles, or group of Nobles, suggesting, recommending, opposing, or containing the names of proposed candidates for office in the temple is prohibited.
- **(b)** Expenditures Prohibited. The expenditure of money for gifts, favors, or entertainment on behalf of a candidate for elected office is prohibited.
- (c) Violation. For any violation of (a) or (b), the Imperial Potentate may suspend any offending Noble, and he may declare the election of the officers void and order a new election.
- (d) Notice. At least one week prior to the annual meeting or any election, the temple Recorder shall mail to each member a notice thereof containing this section.

Amend. 2011

*Only current up to date members may vote. Door will be title. Wear your Fez!


